The General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)

The GDPR is a new EU/UK legal framework which came into operation on 25 May 2018; it introduces additional regulations for all organisations including charities - which process (collect, manage and use) personal data. It supersedes the 1998 Data Protection Act, and while the new legislation does not introduce widespread changes to existing law, it gives individuals more rights, and protection in how their personal data is used. Personal data relates to a living individual who can be identified from that data. However, noncompliance with the new legislation will increase the monetary penalties.

Your Rights

- your data will not be shared or used for any other purpose
- · you may withdraw from the data base at any time
- · you may make anonymous donations if you wish to do so
- · you may see what data is held relating to you, and you may amend it if necessary
- if you have any queries, these should be directed to the HCS Chair, who acts as the Data Protection Lead

Consent Form

All members are required to opt in or out, via the consent form, unless they do not wish to receive HCS information by post, email or phone, or for their photograph to be displayed on the HCS website or in any other publicity.

The Data Base

This is held by the designated Committee member. HCS has a legal duty not to disclose data except to HMRC, in order to claim Gift Aid. HCS also has a legal duty to disclose information to investigative authorities, eg the police, if requested to do so.
